

- C. Demonstrate understanding of LS tools and assemble tools within each of the four perceptual strengths.
- D. Create LS lesson plans and a complete Contract Activity Package.
- E. Assess research base of strategies to be used with diverse learners.

6. Instructional Methods:

The primary method of instruction will be lecture from 9:00a.m.-12:00p.m., and small group work between 1:30p.m.-4:30p.m. The lecture will include learning course content through a variety of interactive learning styles instructional methods. The small group work will provide time for participants to develop their Learning Styles lesson plans, tools, and Contract Activity Packet.

7. Course Calendar:

The class will meet from June 9-20, 2008 from 9:00 a.m. – 4:30p.m.

8. Attendance Policy:

Attendance is mandatory for all sessions.

9. Course Assignment:

Students must complete a multi-sensory instructional unit that includes a contract activity packet to pass the course.

Students will submit an extra copy of their contract activity packet for potential publication through the AINE Learning Styles Center. AINE will seek the consent of the contributing student in order to use this material in any publications.

10. Evaluation:

Students will be evaluated based on attendance, participation, and the completion and presentation of a multi-sensory instructional unit. Grading will be pass/fail basis.

The Multi-sensory Instructional Unit consists of the following

- i. Contract Activity Packet
- ii. Minimum of four activities
- iii. A pre/post-assessment instrument
